

Beaconhills College Internet Certificate Instructions

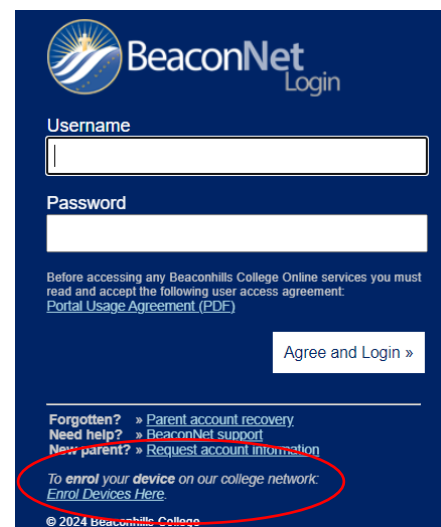
iPad Installation

To access the Internet at the College, a certificate needs to be installed on all devices. We have recently updated the certificate and here are the instructions to install this on your iPad.

You should not be getting an error message when trying to browse the internet at school.

1. In Safari, please browse to <https://portal.beaconhills.vic.edu.au> and if necessary, log out so you are at the sign in screen as shown here.

2. At the very bottom, tap on “Enrol Devices Here”

3. Tap on iPad Config file.

Network Access

To access the College WiFi network, all students are **required** to install a security certificate onto any device used at school – iPad or laptop.

This can only be done on the school grounds and you will need your username and password to do this. This certificate does no more than identify you and your device as members of the Beaconhills community and allows access to the Internet while on campus.

Any VPN installed on a device can disrupt Internet access on College grounds and should be removed or switched off.

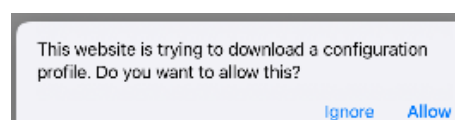
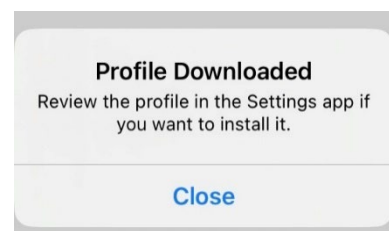

Mac Desktop Config File

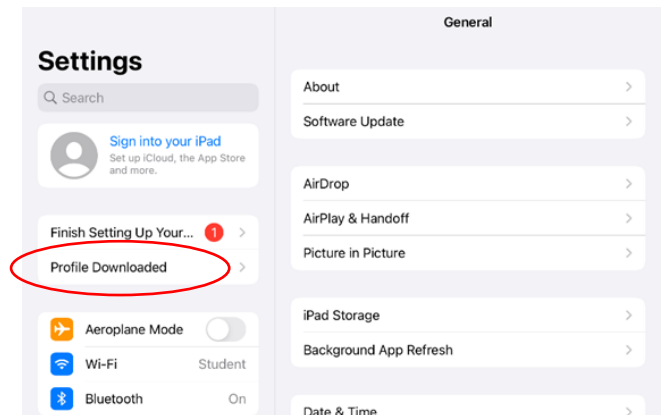

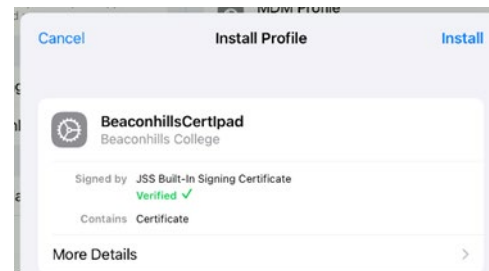
4. Tap **Allow** and then **Close**. It will download a file to your iPad Settings.

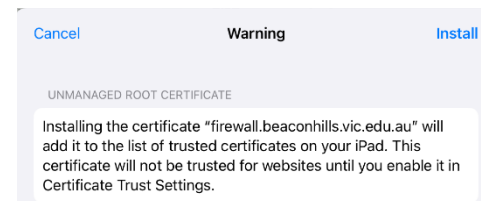
5. Go to iPad settings and tap on **Profile Downloaded**.



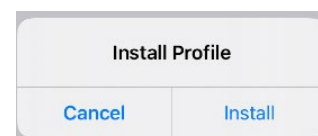
6. Tap **Install** and enter your **iPad passcode**.



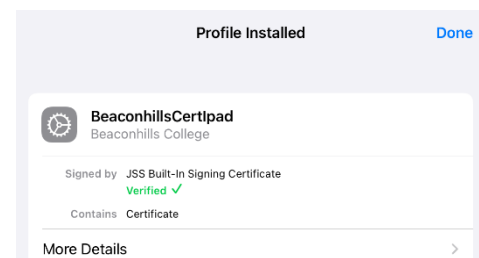
7. Tap **Install** again.



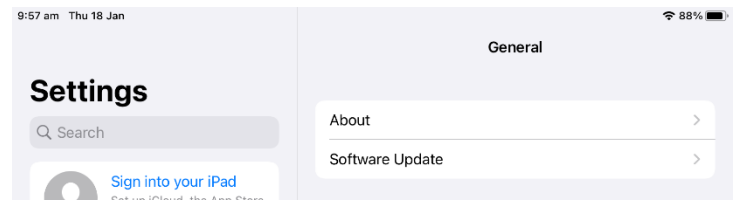
8. Tap **install** again.



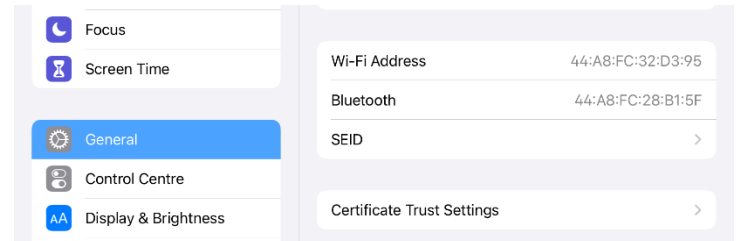
9. Tap **Done**



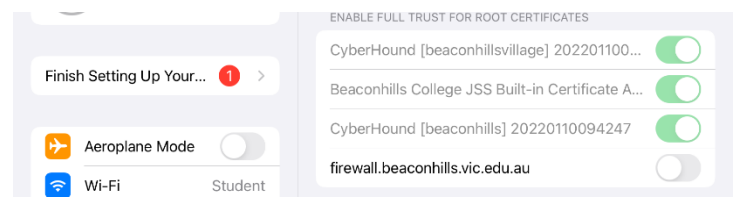
10. **IMPORTANT LAST STEP**
Now to **Settings - General - About**



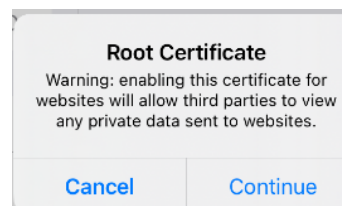
11. Go to Certificate Trust Settings
